**habitō, habitāre, habitāvī, habitātus** - to dwell, to live (inhabit)  
**laudō, laudāre, laudāvī, laudātus** -to praise (laud, *summa cum laude*)  
**narrō, narrāre, narrāvī, narrātus** - to tell (narrative, narrator)  
**parō, parāre, parāvī, parātus** - to prepare (*semper parātus*)  
**portō, portāre, portāvī, portātus** - to carry (transport, report)  
**pugnō, pugnāre, pugnāvī, pugnātus** - to fight (pugnacious Dan Brown)  
**regnō, regnāre, regnāvī, regnātus** - to reign; to rule  
**servō, servāre, servāvī, servātus** - to save (preservation)  
**spectō, spectāre, spectāvī, spectātus** - to watch (spectator, inspection)  
**stō, stāre, stetī, status** (estoy; substantive, status quo)  
**vocō, vocāre, vocāvī, vocātus** - to call (advocate, evoke, convocation, vocation)



**dēbeō, dēbere, dēbuī, dēbitus** - owe; ought + complementary infinitive  
**doceō, docēre, docuī, doctus** -to teach (docent, doctor, indoctrinate)  
**habeō, habēre, habuī, habitus** - to have (*avoir, avere, haber*)  
**maneō, manēre, mansī, mansus** - to remain, to stay  
**moneō, monēre, monuī, monitus** - to warn, to advise (admonition, admonish, monitor)  
**moveō, movēre, movī, mōtus** - to move (movable, motion)  
**sedeō, sedēre, sēdī, sessus** - to sit (sedentary, sediment, sedimentary. obsession)  
**teneō, tenēre, tenuī, tentus** - to hold, to possess (tenacious)  
**videō, vidēre, vīdī, vīsus** - to see (video, vision)

**agō, agere, ēgī, actus** - to do, to lead (agent, agenda, action)  
**currō, currere, cucurrī, cursus** - to run (current, curriculum; *correr*)  
**dīcō, dīcere, dīxī, dictus** - to say (dictation, dictionary)  
**dūcō, dūcere, dūxī, ductus** - to lead (duct, aqueduct, conduct, produce)  
**legō, legere, lēgī, lectus** - to pick, to chose; to read (lecture, election, selection)  
**mittō, mittere, mīsī, missus** - to send (transmit, mission)  
**pōnō, ponere, posuī, positus** - to put, to place (exponent, position)  
**regō, regere, rēxī, rēctus** - to rule, govern, guide, control, direct (homo erectus; regulate)  
**trahō, trahere, traxī, tractus** - to pull, to drag (tractor, attraction)  
**vincō, vincere, vīcī, victus** - to conquer (invincible; *veni, vidi, vici*)  
**vīvō, vīvere, vīxī** - to live (vivacious)

**capiō, capere, cēpī, captus** - to take, to capture (captive, capture, caption)  
**faciō, facere, fēcī, factus** - to do, to make (fact, manufacture)  
**fugiō, fugere, fūgī** - to flee (refugee, fugitive, centrifuge)  
**iaciō, iacere, iecī, iactus** - to throw (reject, object)  
**rapīō, rapere, rapuī, raptus** - to seize (rapacious, rapture, rapine, raptor)

**aperiō, aperīre, aperuī, apertus** - to open (aperture; *abierto, abrir*)  
**audiō, audīre, audīvī, audītus** - to hear (audio, audible, audit, audition)  
**saliō, salīre, saluī, saltus** - to leap, to jump (salient)  
**sentīō, sentīre, sensī, sensus** (sensitive, sentient)  
**sciō, scīre, scīvī, scītus** - to know (omniscient, science)  
**veniō, venīre, vēnī, ventūrus** - to come (*venir*; advent, adventure; *veni, vidi, vici*)

**possum, posse, potuī** - to be able (*potis + sum*) + complementary infinitive  
**sum, esse, fuī, futūrus** - to be (*ser* in Spanish; future)
