

**Artistic Project:**  
**Poster of Juno, Pallas, Ajax, Aeolus and his Windy World on the Aeolian Islands**

- 1) Reread in Latin the Death of Ajax and Aeolus/Juno episode from Vergil's *Aeneid* and, as you read, visual all the elements of this episode of the *Aeneid*. Note how the winds are personified. See me, if you need help with reading the story.
- 2) In the form of a poster illustrate this story visually by drawing each element as part of a wholistic composition. More elements you include the more points you receive. If you have not artistic talent use a ruler to keep yourself on the straight path.
- 3) Label each element or thing in our picture with the full dictionary entry of the Latin word or concept.
- 4) Extra points will be given for artistic brilliance, detailed depictions and abundant labeling in Latin. You may also wish to include some dialogue in caption bubbles or another format.
- 5) I do realize that the gods have not distributed artistic talent equally but do your best to imagine what Vergil's words depict and what the world of Aeolus would look like.
- 6) You may wish to take this project in a creative direction of your own. **There is bank paper in the classroom for your rough draft.**
